Luckily, hoteliers in the area are ready and waiting with Valentine's Day package deals.

The beautiful **Ocean Lodge** overlooks Cannon Beach's Haystack Rock, and their "Romantic Interlude at the Beach" package includes a selection of Pacifica skincare products, a chilled bottle of Domaine Ste. Michelle sparkling wine, two Ocean Lodge flutes, and Verdun chocolates. This package is an \$89 add-on to any room you choose at the lodge. The **Alderbrook Resort & Spa** on the Hood Canal is offering a "Surprise My Valentine" package that includes a \$70 credit at the resort's restaurant, a bottle of wine, and a dozen roses. Both Alderbrook Valentine packages are available from February 10-18, 2012.

The **Iron Springs Resort** on the Washington Coast lets you book an entire cabin for your stay, each with a fireplace or wood-burning stove and an ocean view. Their "Shore-ly in Love" package includes a two-night stay, a bottle of Champagne, a box of Oh! chocolates, and cinnamon rolls. This package starts at \$341, and it's available from February 10-19, 2012.
